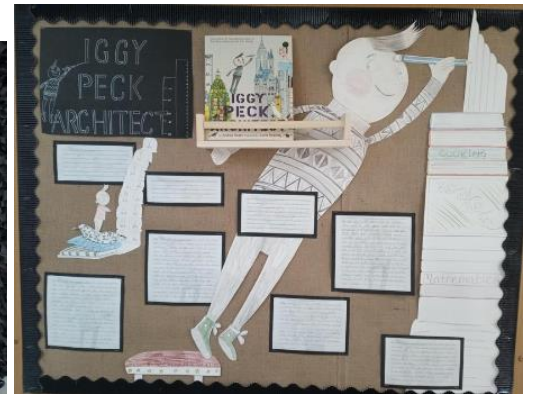

Writing Ambassadors

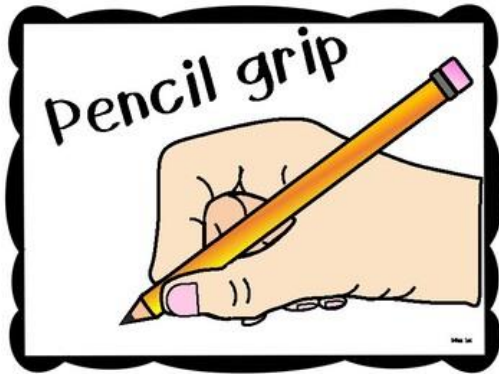

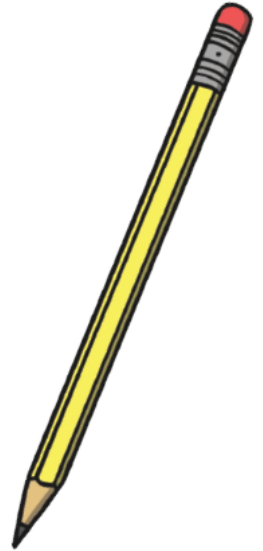
